### Entries:

Entries received by October 28, 2011 will be \$15/head per show. If the same animal is entered in all three shows and the entries are received by October 28, then the total entry for that animal is \$40. Entries received after October 28 will be \$20/hd/show or \$50 for all three shows.

Entries will be accepted until 8am November 5 for Show 1, 12 noon November 5 for show 2, and 8am November 6 for Show 3. Check-in for each show must be completed at these times as well.

Shows will be held at the Muskogee Fairgrounds, Hog Barn. Address for the fairgrounds is 1444 S. Cherokee St. Muskogee, OK 74403. Directions to the fairgrounds. From the intersection of Main Street (Hiway 64) and Okmulgee, go three blocks east to C Street. Turn south on C Street and drive approximately 1 mile. You will see the fair grounds. The hog barn is located on the south side of the round barn.
